TIME: All Events: 9:00 a.m. PLACE: Mesilla, New Mexico. Mesilla is adjacent to and southwest of Las Cruces.

AGE GROUPS, 10K: 18 & Under, 19-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, and 70 & Over (Male and Female). 5K WALK: 18 & Under, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70 & Over (Male & Female). 5K RUN: 12 & Under, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, 19-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 70 & Over (Male & Female).

ENTRY FEE: All Events: \$18 early registration; \$23 after COB March 5, 2007.

REGISTRATION: By mail, completed registration form plus check, postmarked no later than March 5. By phone, (505) 524-7824, until 7 p.m., March 7. Packet pickup/ registration: Friday, March 9, 5-7 p.m., Mesilla Valley Inn Lobby, or Race Day, March 10, at Start Line, 7:30 to 8:45 a.m. Registration will close 8:45 a.m.

AWARDS: All pre-registered participants will receive a T-shirt on race day. We make every effort to purchase enough shirts to cover the rest of the field of participants. All events: Custom rosettes to top three finishers in each age group. Awards to first male and female open (19-39) and masters (40+) finishers. No duplicate awards.

RACE HQS: Mesilla Valley Inn, 901 Avenida de Mesilla, Las Cruces, (505)524-8603. Special: \$56 per night for up to 4 persons (plus tax). Remember to enter "Mesilla Valley Track Club" under "Company Name" on the motel registration form.

NEW MEXICO GRAND PRIX: The 10K is also the first race in the 2007 New Mexico Grand Prix series, a series of races held throughout the state. For Gran Prix scoring, you must have a current USATF card and NM residency.

DIRECTIONS: Take Interstate 10 to Exit 140 (Avenida de Mesilla), go west 0.8 miles to Old Mesilla, turn left into the large "Plaza Parking" lot. Overflow parking at San Andres High School is accessed via a separate entrance just south of Plaza Parking. Race day registration will occur at the covered patio at the front of Plaza Parking. The starting line is located in the street in front of Plaza Parking. The finish line is three short blocks west on Calle de Medanos.
